RE: URGENT LETTER OF DEMAND

Your letter dated 13 October 2020 on the above subject bears reference.

The removal of office bearers in institutions supporting constitutional democracy (Chapter 9 institutions) is strictly regulated by the Constitution and the Assembly Rules, and is not a matter that is in the hands of the Speaker.

When a motion to remove any office bearer is submitted and meets the requirements set out in the rules, Speaker <u>must</u> immediately refer the motion, and any supporting documentation provided by the member, to an independent panel appointed by the Speaker for a preliminary assessment of the matter; and inform the Assembly and the President of such referral without delay. I regret therefore that I cannot accede to your request to set aside the removal processes in respect of the Public Protector initiated by the National Assembly.
